**FLOWER:** Bright red - Fuchsia



**HABIT:** Spreading, flat-topped with age.

**CULTURE:** Generally crabapples require little pruning, but if it is done, it should be completed before early June. Most crabapples initiate flower buds for the next season in mid-june to early July and pruning at this time will result in decreased flower production the following year. Pruning off suckers is a good idea anytime of year. Performs best in full sun for blooms.

**FRUIT:** Few fruits are formed.
