
LEAF COLOR: Dainty small dark green foliage.

**HABIT:** Dainty, dwarf type forming a rounded, bushy head.

**CULTURE:** Generally crabapples rquire little prunning, but if an is done, it should be completed before early June. Most crabapples iniate flower buds for the next season in mid-june to early july and pruning at this time will result in decreased flower production the following year. Pruning off suckers is a good idea anytime of year. Performs best in full sun for blooms.

FLOWER: Coral pink buds open to double rose pink flowers.

FRUIT: Few, 1/2" diamete, bronze, reddish orange.
