# Kentucky Coffee Tree

SUMMER



SIZE:

H 60'-75' x W 40'-50'

BOTANICAL NAME:

*Gymnocladus dioica* (*dioica*)

COMMON NAME:

Coffee Tree

WINTER



**LEAF COLOR:** Large compound leaves. One of the last trees to leaf out in spring, new leaves are pinkish to purplish tinges gradually changing to dark green, almost bluish green, FALL: ineffective, some yellow.

**HABIT:** Irregular branches ascending, oval open crown, picturesque; barelimbed and somewhat clumsy looking in winter. Interesting! Roots not a problem, very sound structure.

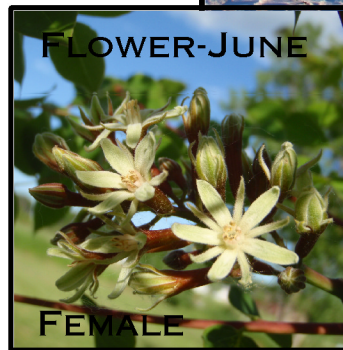
**CULTURE:** Deep, rich, moist soil for best growth; however adaptable to a wide range of conditions; limestone, drought, and city conditions, prune in winter or early spring.

**GROWTH RATE:** Medium

**FLOWER:** Dioecious, Greenish white; late may to early june. Female fragrant 8-12" long x 3-4" wide panicles. Male 1/3 size.

**FRUIT:** Reddish brown, leathery pod, 5-10" long, 1 1/2 to 2" wide containing a few hard-shelled rounded seeds, inbedded in a sweet, sticky pulp; ripens in October, but hang on tree throught winter.
