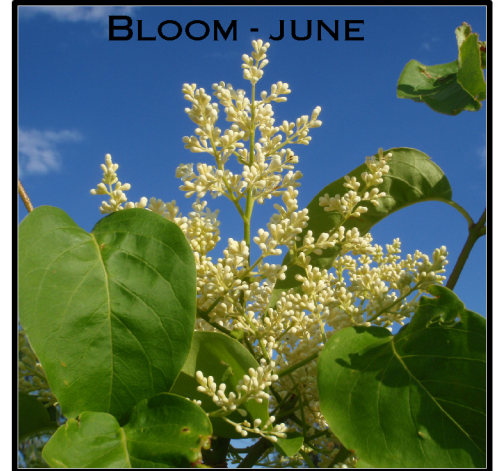

LEAF COLOR: Leaves have a warm light reddish tinge, then turn very dark, glossy green and 3 to 6 inches long, half as wide, with long, tapered tip. The medium dark green leaves are slightly fuzzy underneath. The deciduous leaves turn pale greenish-brown in autumn before dropping.

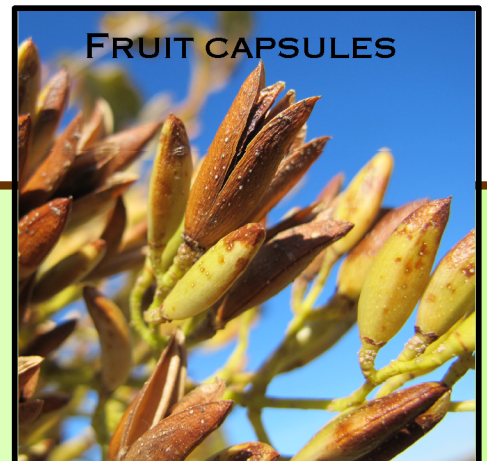
HABIT: Graceful with spreading branches that form an oval to rounded crown.

CULTURE: Growth is best on moist, well-drained, fertile soils and full sun will tolerate some shade. Prompt removal of faded flower panicles before seed set will increase bloom in the following year. Prune immediately after flowering. A cultivar of Japanese Tree Lilac

GROWTH RATE: medium, prefers full sun. Try fertilizing regularly to help prevent diseases.

FLOWER: Large fragrant clusters of white or creamy white blooms in summer. It's puts on a long dramatic show. Flowers may be pruned to promote vegetative growth.

FRUIT: Cluster of capsules containing seeds that are scattered by the wind. Not messy
