LEAF COLOR: Dark green thick leaves in the summer, changing to a dependable fall color of gold, scarlet, orange, red and pink. More reds than other sugar maples.

HABIT: Cone shape Upright

CULTURE: Excellent resistance to sunscald and frost crack. Full sun with good moisture well drained soil conditions. (loam - sand). acid to Neutral. Resistant to breakage. Drought tolerant.

GROWTH RATE: Faster than other sugars

FRUIT: Samara (wings) 1.75"
