Sissy Ullmann and Anthony Zimmerli are both featured Artists at the BAA Art Center for the month of February 2025 in a newly painted and refreshed gallery.

Sissy Ullmann was born in Thailand and has lived in Bakersfield since 1974. She considers herself a landscape painter whose medium is oil paint on canvas. Although Sissy has only been a professional artist for 10 years, as a child she was constantly drawing and continued to do so as an adult. She says that it is important to her that anyone looking at her work can feel as if they were standing where she's standing when she paints and feel her joy in the work as well..

Anthony Zimmerli studied at the art Institute of Los Angeles before joining the Navy In 2002. After he returned to civilian life, he continued his studies in art first at Taft College and then Bakersfield College where he obtained a certificate in graphics and his Associate of Arts degree. Anthony joined the BAA In 2023 where he continues to study art and build his skills. He says he loves to use all forms of Art mediums and materials so that he can focus the viewers' attention on the painting.

Both Sissy and Anthony are part

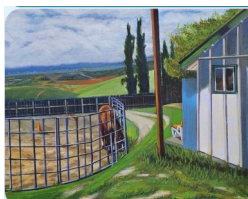
of a larger group that meet each week to paint Plein Air on locations in the surrounding Bakersfield area.



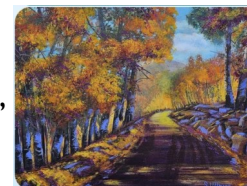

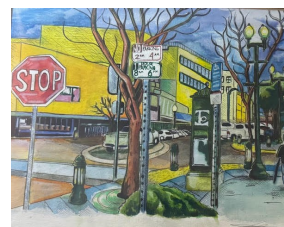

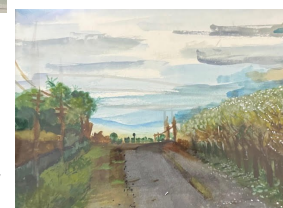

DAGNY'S FEATURED ARTIST, VICKI MEADOWS

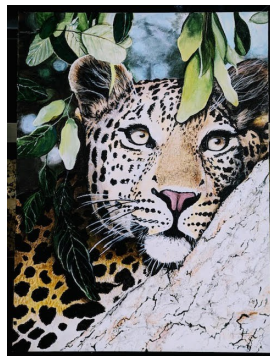
Vicki Meadows will be the featured artist at Dagny's for both **February and March**. Her show is titled "Something Old and Something New".

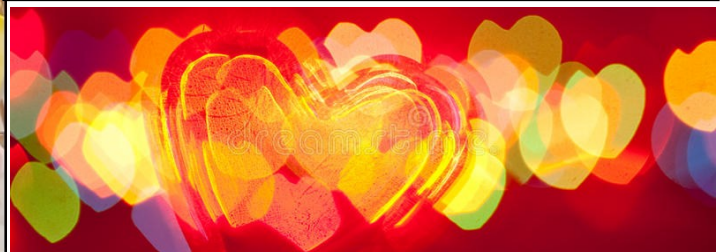
