Iva Fendrick is the featured artist at the Bakersfield Art Center for the month of June 2025. Join her for a reception on First Friday, June 6th from 6-8 pm

Over the years, Iva has worked in a variety of mediums and subject matters. These include portraits in pencil and pastels, nude figure studies, sculpture, figures, abstracts, and mixed media, and her latest art adventure, Plein Air. She is the daughter of Vina Cross, who was one of the Bakersfield Art Association founding members. Iva is also a fourth generation Kern County resident.

Iva earned a bachelor's degree in art from California State University, Bakersfield, having also studied at Bakersfield College and the Art Center School of Design in Los Angeles. She studied ceramics with Vic Bracke of Central California and at the Mendocino Art Center School of Design in Los Angeles. Iva taught in the Kern High School District, much of the time teaching ceramics.

Artistic expression has always been part of her life, from drawing quick sketches to creating water features for that quiet garden spot. Iva feels that the "Artist Eye" is always at work. She says, "When I see the soft shadows on the rolling hillsides, I long to capture that mood for others to enjoy." Iva feels that we all need to reflect upon what gives us visual pleasure.

Many of those creations are in the hands of private collectors and can be seen at BAA's Art Center.

Over the years Iva has contributed to young students' artistic endeavors, beginning with classes in her home, conducting workshops, museum, and teaching in the Kern High School District. She's subscribed to the well-known quote. "Science makes life possible, art makes life livable."

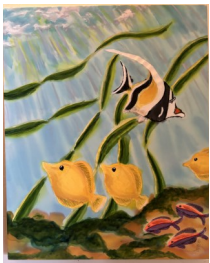

All juried BAA members may participate in BAA Satellite Art Shows. All artwork submitted must be original with the artist; and, free reference photos are acceptable.

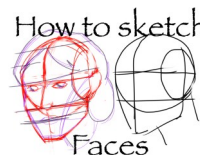
Put title of the painting/photograph, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address & phone number on the back of each painting/photograph. 16"x20" is recommended size. 11"x14" is ok. Some locations may take larger pieces. D-rings only. All work must have wire for hanging. Please tape wire & use transparent shipping tape. Wires must hang 2 inches from top of frame when painting/photograph is hung.

Price tags for Satellite Art Shows available in the Art Center office, the third drawer of the file cabinet. Use black pen when writing on labels. Labels will be taped on the bottom right corner or frame w/ transparent shipping tape. 30% or 40% commission depending on location purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price, plus the tax, to the Treasurer.
