As a self-taught artist, she believes that her talent was gifted from God. Art isn't always happy for her but the results are a good diversion from the problems and stress in her life. Art really helped her in a self-care process to overcome chronic pain in 2005.

For the last 5 years, Jeanette has been teaching art, seeing and other skills while donating her time with other seniors at an ADELANTE Group in Arvin, California in self-care healing processes. The group consists of elderly ladies who have immigrated from Mexico and raised families and worked in the fields. Adelante is a place where they can heal from their illness and stress. Her classes are held at the Arvin Community Center on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

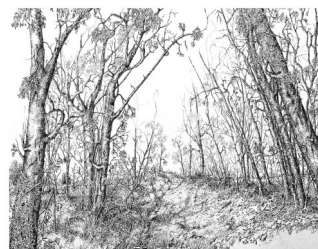

Vicki Meadows is the featured artist at Dagny's Coffee Shop at 1600 20th Street for the month of July.

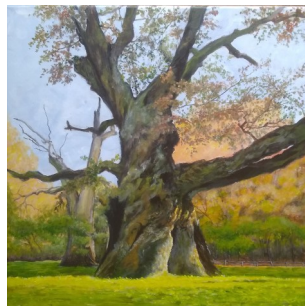

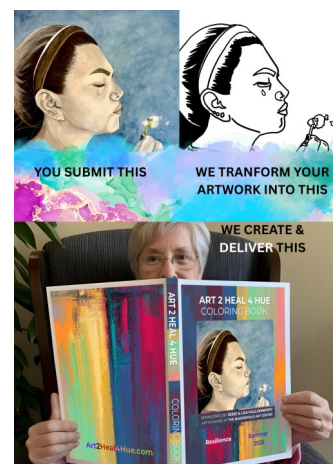
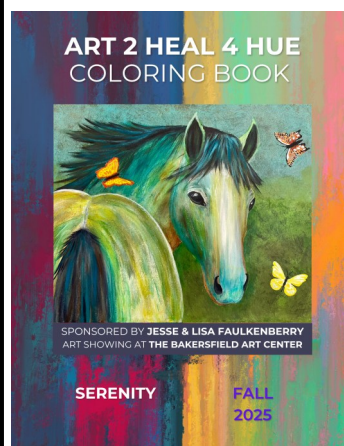

SATELLITE ART SHOWS IN BUSINESS - GUIDELINES

For all BAA members to have a chance to exhibit, wait one year before exhibiting at the same location a 2nd time. Also, only exhibit in one location each month. All juried BAA members may participate in BAA Satellite Art Shows. All artwork submitted must be original with the artist; and, free reference photos are acceptable.

Put title of the painting/photograph, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address & phone number on the back of each painting/photograph. 16"x20" is recommended size. 11"x14" is ok. Some locations may take larger pieces. D-rings only. All work must have wire for hanging. Please tape wire & use transparent shipping tape. Wires must hang 2 inches from top of frame when painting/photograph is hung.

Price tags for Satellite Art Shows available in the Art Center office, the third drawer of the file cabinet. Use black pen when writing on labels. Labels will be taped on the bottom right corner or frame w/ transparent shipping tape. 30% or 40% commission depending on location purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price, plus the tax, to the Treasurer.

SECOND SATURDAY FREE CLASS
