Plein air painting is the practice of painting a finished artwork outdoors, capturing the natural light, color, and movement of the subject in real time. The term comes from the French phrase en plein air, which translates to "in the open air.

Plein air painting became popular in the 19th century, especially among Impressionist painters like Claude Monet, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, and Camille Pissarro. Their works



often featured loose brushstrokes and vibrant colors to convey the mood and atmosphere of the scene."
