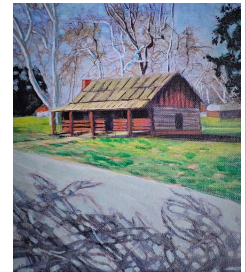

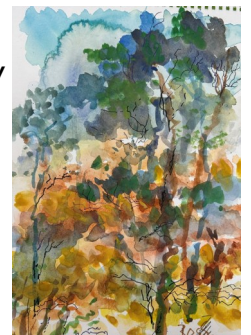

Oil Pastels on Newspaper

The April art exhibit at Dagny's will feature Oil Pastels on Newspaper by Charlotte White. The Meet the Artist will be on Friday April 3rd at 6:00 p.m. Dagny's Coffee Shop is located at 1601 20th Street in Bakersfield.

Recently an observer asked with a perplexed look on their face, "Why draw on the newspaper?" Drawing on alternative materials started approximately 25 years ago when Charlotte went to the Hollywood Bowl for a Jazz concert. After parking her car, walking quite a distance carrying a gourmet picnic lunch and assorted art supplies, Charlotte became aware that she had left her drawing pad in the car. Frustrated with her oversight and not wanting to hike back to the parking lot, she decided to search the concourse for something to draw on. Upon discovering a Los Angeles Times newspaper stand, she purchased a hand full of the papers. Then returning to her seat in the "nose-bleed section," spent the day sketching the audience because she could barely make out the performers on stage.

Since then, she has enjoyed drawing and painting on shopping bags, newspapers, menus, maps, game boards, and clothing.

One art admirer in the Art Center recently said of her work, "They make me think of Van Gogh's paintings." Charlotte's smiling response was, "Thank you and you have just added \$100.00 to the price!"

SATELLITE ART SHOWS IN BUSINESS - GUIDELINES

- So that all BAA members have a chance to exhibit, an artist must wait one year before exhibiting at the same location a second time. Also artists can only exhibit in two locations each month. All BAA members, who have been juried, may participate in BAA Satellite Art Shows.
- All artwork submitted must be original with the artist. All reference photographs, used in the creative process must be taken by the artist.
- Put the title of the painting/photograph, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address and phone number of the back of every painting/photograph.
- 16" x 20" is the recommended size. 11" x 14" is ok. Some locations may take larger pieces.
- D-rings only. All work must have a wire for hanging. Please tape wire end using transparent shipping tape. Wires must hang two inches from the top of the frame when the painting/photograph is hung.
- Pick up price tags for Satellite Art Shows at the Art Center office, in the third drawer of the file cabinet, and use a black pen when writing on the labels. Labels will be taped on the bottom right corner of the frame with transparent shipping tape.
- 30% or 40% commission depending on location. When purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price, plus the tax, to the Treasurer.

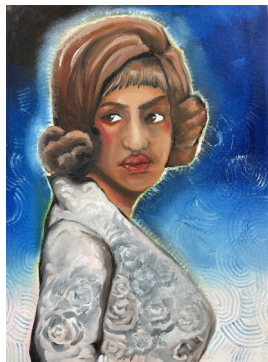
