FEATURED ARTIST: CHARLOTTE WHITE

“Oil Pastels on the Bakersfield Californian” collection by Charlotte White will celebrate with a reception on First Friday, May 1st from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Art Center, 1607 19th Street. The exhibition will be on display throughout May. Charlotte will also be exhibiting at Dagny's during the month of May.

Charlotte has been comfortable sitting along Kern County road-sides for 33 years, capturing the landscape and architecture of the region, resulting in a shift from painting with oils and moving into oil pastels. The May exhibit at the Center will feature fresh paintings created in plein air (on location). She welcomes suggestions for paintings of local locations.

White, a widow, has 36 years of teaching experience, 20 years for the Kern High School District and 10 years for Valley Oaks Charter High School. She currently is leading a Figure Drawing group at the Art Center on Monday afternoons and the Plein Air Sketching group on Thursday mornings at the Kern County Museum.

The following are paragraphs about some of the oil pastels on the Bakersfield Californian newsprint:

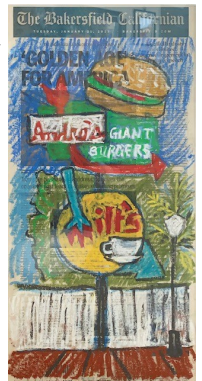
“Water Pipes Going to Las Angeles” was created in a field near Mettler. I wanted to see the installation at the base of the Grapevine but I was turned away at the gate. I drove down the road got out of the car and sketched.



The oil pastel on newsprint drawing is of the entrance to the “Nut Festival”, held at the Kern County Museum a couple of years ago. An elaborate entrance had been created that reminded me of Disney Land. The morning after the event closed I sat by the Clock Tower to sketch.



“Andre's and Milt's” old signs featured in the Neon Plaza is the inspiration for this oil pastel on newspaper. Andre's is still in business serving delicious burgers and fries on Brundage, while Milt's is under new ownership. One Thursday morning I just had to capture likenesses of the two signs.



“The Bakersfield National Cemetery” was created on Saturday, May 23, 2015, Bakersfield Californian newsprint. I drove on Memorial Day to pause and reflect. There were small American flags decorating the tombstones. The scene was worthy of a sketch as citizens walked along the paths bringing flowers.

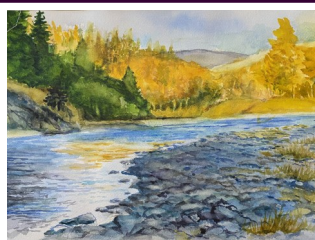

José Silva will conduct a free demonstration of portrait painting at the Bakersfield Art Center on May 9th, after a brief General meeting which starts at 10 a.m. The Art Center is located at 1607 19th St., Bakersfield, CA.

Those interested in taking a workshop on the same subject can sign up at the Art Center for the workshop to be held on May 23rd. The workshop is from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. The cost of the workshop is \$65 for members and \$75 for non-members.

Artist profile: Jose Silva (b. 1998, Kern County, California) is an American oil painter whose work began with a lifelong focus on drawing before evolving into classical oil painting. Growing up in a small town, he developed a strong sense of form, proportion, and light through self-study, and careful observation. This foundation is carried into his painting, where he builds images slowly through layered oils, subtle value shifts, and controlled edges. His work reflects a respect for traditional techniques while using oil paint to explore depth and atmosphere.

Over time, Silva's paintings have moved beyond strict realism into a more cinematic and emotional approach. Using light and shadow as storytelling tools, he creates images that feel intimate and mysterious figures emerging from darkness and surfaces rich with texture. His practice is defined by patience and control, blending classical skill with a modern sense of mood, inviting viewers into work that is not just seen, but felt.

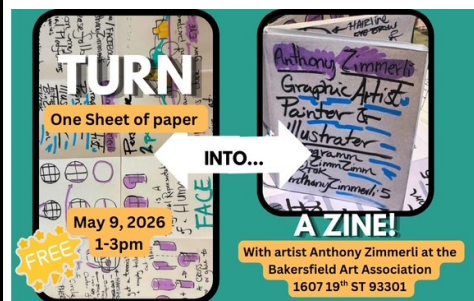
SECOND SATURDAY FREE ART ACTIVITY

SATELLITE ART SHOWS IN BUSINESS - GUIDELINES

So that all BAA members have a chance to exhibit, an artist must wait one year before exhibiting at the same location a second time. Also artists can only exhibit in two locations each month. All BAA members, who have been juried, may participate in BAA Satellite Art Shows.

All artwork submitted must be original with the artist. All reference photographs, used in the creative process must be taken by the artist.

Put the title of the painting/photograph, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address and phone number of the back of every painting/photograph.

16" x 20" is the recommended size. 11" x 14" is ok. Some locations may take larger pieces.

D-rings only. All work must have a wire for hanging. Please tape wire end using transparent shipping tape. Wires must hang two inches from the top of the frame when the painting/photograph is hung.

Pick up price tags for Satellite Art Shows at the Art Center office, in the third drawer of the file cabinet, and use a black pen when writing on the labels. Labels will be taped on the bottom right corner of the frame with transparent shipping tape.

30% or 40% commission depending on location. When purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price, plus the tax, to the Treasurer.
