
"Watercolor

Neil explains, "Watercolor Challenge' was designed to lift both beginning and experienced artists above a YouTube tutorial or an art lecture." Each class has time for sharing individual artwork with a give and take that encourages growth of the artist. Art students often confess how painting is a therapy and a window to their soul, a sentiment echoed in Watercolor Challenge. In such an environment, deep attachment has grown for the class.

ment, deep attachment has grown for the class.
Watercolor, generally considered by artists to be a medium offering great beauty and a long learning curve, requires the control of the water while being able to react to the spontaneity inherent in the medium. Neil, who has worked in different mediums, maintains the fluid medium continually offers challenges and rewards to the artist and endless possibilities for artistic expression.

Watercolor Challenge, which had been meeting twice a month prior to Covid-19 bringing inperson classes to a halt, has stayed together with frequent emails, phone calls and one on one visits. The June BAA show is the first as a group though several members are experienced with previous group and solo shows. Watercolor Challenge members come from different backgrounds, where they have shown leadership i.e. medicine, education, landscape design, and law enforcement plus being accomplished in other creative mediums i.e. creative writing, photography, and music.

Besides the classes, the group has attended workshops and art retreats together and looks forward to more as Covid loosen its grip on our world.



Put the title of the painting, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address, and phone number **on the back** of every painting/photograph.

· 16" x 20" recommend size. 11" x 14" is

ok. Some locations may take larger pieces.

D-rings only. All work must have a wire for hanging. Please tape wire ends. No masking tape.

• Pick up **price tags for Satellite Art Shows** at the gallery, and bring a black ballpoint pen for invoices.

· 30% to 40% commission depending on location.

• When purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price of the art sold, plus the tax, to the Treasurer. The Treasurer will then issue checks to the artist and the Satellite Art Show Hosts.




