**TRIBUTE SHOW:  
REMEMBERING BOB ROSS**

Bob was a lifelong artist, educator and lover of the California landscape. Born and raised in Bakersfield Ca he spent much of his life exploring the natural world through his art. As a young teenager, Bob found inspiration in a mentor named Ed Moody. A retired forest ranger, Mr. Moody taught Bob to observe nature



closely and appreciate its beauty. Together they explored Lake Isabella, the Kern River, local hot springs and water falls.

Those experiences along with the writing of John Muir, helped shape Bob's lifelong connection with the outdoors and became a lasting influence on his art work.



Bob studied under renowned local artists Clayton Rippey, Al Naso, Shirley Leonard and Darlene Ostercamp. Bob attended San Jose University as a Fine Arts Major. He went on to become a graphics designer. Bob dedicated many years to teaching art, including teaching for 15 years with the Kern County Superintendent of Schools.

He also was an instructor for Home Educators Resource Center. He was an active member, exhibiting artist and instructor with the Bakersfield Art Association.

He was inspired by the work of Claude Monet, Vincent Van Gogh, and Andrew Wyeth. But he developed his own distinctive artistic style that blended expressionism and impressionism. He worked in watercolor, acrylic and oil creating vibrant landscapes filled with color, movement and emotion.



His soft imaginative scenes invited his viewers to freely interpret his paintings. Bob often reflected on the words of Clayton Rippey "The strength of your strokes or your mark making is everything. Make your marks with confidence"

Through his paintings, teachings and encouragement of fellow artists, Bob shared his love of art and nature with

## VICKI MEADOWS AT DAGNY'S

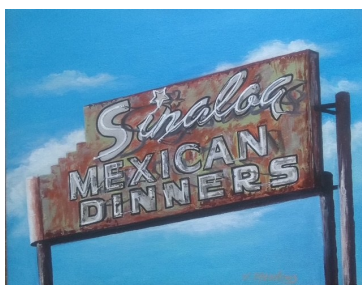

## SATELLITE ART SHOWS IN BUSINESS - GUIDELINES

So that all BAA members have a chance to exhibit, an artist must wait one year before exhibiting at the same location a second time. Also artists can only exhibit in two locations each month. All BAA members, who have been juried, may participate in BAA Satellite Art Shows.

All artwork submitted must be original with the artist.

Put the title of the painting/photograph, medium, copyright date/date painted, artist's name, address and phone number of the back of every painting/photograph.

16" x 20" is the recommended size. 11" x 14" is ok. Some locations may take larger pieces.

D-rings only. All work must have a wire for hanging. Please tape wire end using transparent shipping tape. Wires must hang two inches from the top of the frame when the painting/photograph is hung.

Pick up price tags for Satellite Art Shows at the Art Center office, in the third drawer of the file cabinet, and use a black pen when writing on the labels. Labels will be taped on the bottom right corner of the frame with transparent shipping tape.

30% or 40% commission depending on location. When purchases are made, the artist must turn in the total price, plus the tax, to the Treasurer.

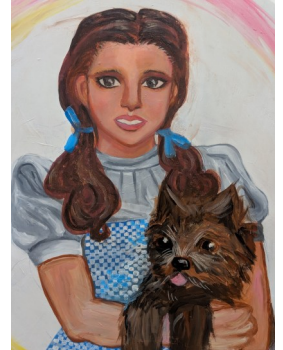

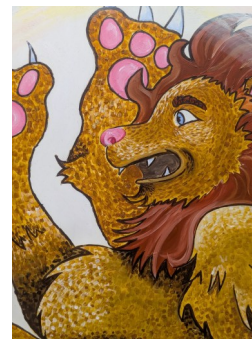
