Laura Lee Best will be the featured artist at the **BAA Art Center** through September.



(by Charlotte White) "A Glimpse of Bakersfield" Mark Engelien is a retired Architect. Mark studied drawing, watercolor, and ceramics as part of his professional training at



Cal Poly, SLO. He was an architect in Bakersfield from 1971 to 2013. From 2014 to 2016, he served as director of the Bakersfield Museum of Art.

Marks early medium for recreational art was watercolor painting. Business pursuits and parenting limited the time he had to dedicate to this activity. Mark began to use ink sketches as a means to create memories of places he and his family visited in their travels.
