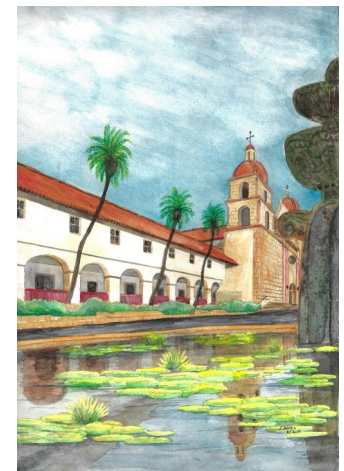
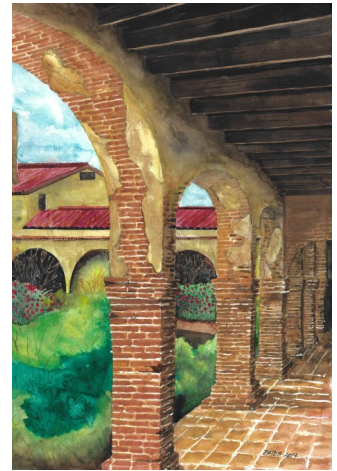

He attended Fresno State where he majored in art and minored in history prior to completing course work to become an art teacher. He has worked in almost all art mediums; photography, pencil, ink, conte crayon, acrylics, oils, watercolors, mixed media as well as a

variety of styles. His work is mostly realistic, and he enjoys the challenge of accurately replicating nature in his paintings. He has been influenced by a variety of artists but as a group, the Flemish Renaissance artists really inspired him to focus on realism and accurately portray his subject matter.

He also enjoys the challenge of drawing and painting fairly difficult subjects. People ask him why and all he can say is “I enjoy the challenge of seeing if I can replicate the image as close as possible.” He finds it very enjoyable. Often when a piece is completed, he is amazed that he was able to make the painting as well as he did. The displayed watercolors are a typical example of his work and his desire to present them accurately.
