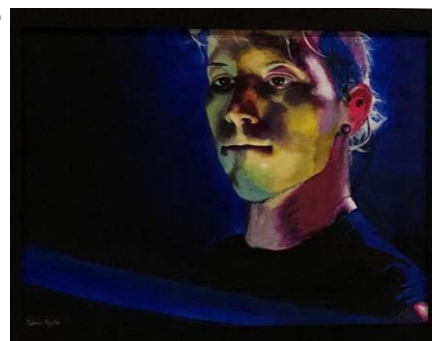
K-12. Youth Art Month has a long history beginning in 1961 when the Art & Creative Materials Institute (ACMI) created Children's Art Month as an event to emphasize the value to children from

participating in visual art education. In 1969 the celebration expanded to include secondary school students, and the Children's Art Month event officially became known as Youth Art Month.

This year the local exhibition will feature student artwork from 20 high schools and 3 middle schools from across Kern County. Bakersfield High Schools include: Highland, Bakersfield, Independence, Foothill, Frontier, Golden Valley, Liberty, South, Centennial, Stockdale, East, North, Vista, Vista West, Central Valley, Tierra Del Sol, West, and high schools from outside of Bakersfield: Burroughs High - Ridgecrest, McFarland, Cesar Chavez - Delano; Middle Schools include: Jacobson Middle School - Tehachapi,



Rosedale, and Beardsley. Students receiving awards from the local show will advance to state judging and state winners will be recognized at the annual conference for the National Art Education

6. The popular vote will be conducted at the June General Meeting;
7. Only BAA members can vote;
8. The committee will meet to make the final selection for the cover and 13 months (Jan. 2021 thru Jan. 2022);
9. All entry artists will be contacted by email or phone, telling which art pieces have been selected for the Calendar;
10. Selected artists will be advised as to when and where to bring their piece to be professionally photographed by member Martin Varga;
11. The originals for the Calendar will be on display at the BAA Art Center featured wall during November 2020; and
12. Calendars and art will be for sale at that time.
