GENERAL MEETING

Nancy Waldron who is teaching the "Water and Sky" workshop on February 15 will be the program for the general meeting on Saturday, February 8 at 10 am. She will show a couple of methods for framing watercolor paintings without needing matting or glass. Stretching and stapling watercolor paper over stretcher bars is one method.
