Invite the Holy Spirit to reveal the verse(s) you should hold onto for healing. Write them down, declare you believe the Word of God is greater than your ailment regularly and combine that with thankfulness for God is faithfully fulfill His Word to you.

Though we have not included all the verses in Scripture on healing, do not limit yourself to only these in holding onto your healing, but do anchor your faith in God's Word. Confidently place your full love in God. He is always reliable because he never changes. Every gift he gives is good and perfect, lacking nothing. (James 1:17) We rejoice already in faith for the healing God is bringing to you.

GENERAL VERSES ON HEALING

Exodus 15:26

and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

2 Kings 5:3 (Pursue your healing)

Then she said to her mistress, "If only my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria! For he would **heal** him of his leprosy."

Psalm 30:2

O LORD my God, I cried out to You, and You healed me.

Psalm 103:3

Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,

Psalm 107:20 (God HAS sent His Word, hold onto it)

He sent His word and **heal**ed them and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 53:5

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are **heal**ed.

Isaiah 58:8

Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your **heal**ing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard.

Malachi 4:2

But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise with **heal**ing in His wings; and you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves.

Hebrews 12:13 (Pursue right living)

And make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be **heal**ed.

1 Peter 2:24

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were **heal**ed.

3 John 1:2 (As we grow in Christ and the Word, healing will come because our faith grows) Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in **heal**th, just as your soul prospers.

JESUS HEALS

Matthew 4:23-24

[Jesus Heals a Great Multitude] And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He **heal**ed them.

Matthew 8:5, 7-8, 13

Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, and Jesus said to him, "I will come and **heal** him."

The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be **heal**ed. Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was **heal**ed that same hour.

Matthew 8:16

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And <u>He cast out the spirits</u> with a word, and <u>healed all who were sick</u>,

Matthew 9:35

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing every sickness and every disease</u> among the people.

Matthew 12:15

But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

Matthew 14:14

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and **heal**ed their sick.

Matthew 15:28 (Jesus heals long distance)

Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was **heal**ed from that very hour.

Matthew 15:29-30 (Jesus heals in the market place of life)

Jesus departed from there, skirted the Sea of Galilee, and went up on the mountain and sat down there.

Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them.

Matthew 19:2

And great multitudes followed Him, and He **heal**ed them there.

Matthew 21:14 (Jesus heals at church)

Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.

Mark 1:34

Then He **heal**ed many who were sick with <u>various diseases</u> and <u>cast out many demons</u>; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

Mark 3:1, 5b

And He entered the synagogue again, and a man was there who had a withered hand.

He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored as whole as the other.

Mark 3:10

For He **heal**ed many, so that as many as had afflictions pressed about Him to touch Him.

Mark 5:21, 23, 29, 34, 41-42 (Statements of Faith in Jesus Ability and Power)

[A Girl Restored to Life and a Woman Healed] Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea.

(A man named, Jairus) begged Him earnestly, saying, "My little <u>daughter lies at the point of death</u>. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be **heal**ed, and she will live."

(A woman touches Jesus while on the way to Jairus' house) Immediately the <u>fountain of her blood</u> was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was **heal**ed of the affliction.

And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace and be **heal**ed (whole in spirit, soul and body) of your affliction."

(At Jairus House) Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, "Talitha, cumi," which is translated, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.

Mark 8:22-25 (Don't stop contending for healing)

Then He came to Bethsaida; and they brought a blind man to Him, and begged Him to touch him.

So He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town. And when He had spit on his eyes and put His hands on him, He asked him if he saw anything.

And he looked up and said, "I see men like trees, walking."

Then He put *His* hands on his eyes again and made him look up. And he was restored and saw everyone clearly.

Luke 4:38-39

[Peter's Mother-in-Law **Heal**ed] Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was <u>sick with a high fever</u>, and they made request of Him concerning her.

So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.

Luke 6:18-19

As well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were **heal**ed.

And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.

Luke 8:2

And certain women who had been <u>healed of evil spirits and infirmities</u>—Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons,

Luke 22:51 (Jesus healing even in persecution)

But Jesus answered and said, "Permit even this." (Arresting Jesus) And He touched his ear (which Peter had cut off) and **heal**ed him.

Matthew 10:1

And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them <u>power over unclean spirits</u>, to cast them out, and to **heal** all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

Matthew 10:8

Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

Luke 9:6

So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.

Luke 10:9

And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

BROKEN HEARTS AND EMOTIONAL WOUNDS

Psalm 147:3

He **heal**s the brokenhearted. And binds up their wounds.

Isaiah 57:18

I have seen his ways and will heal him; I will also lead him and restore comforts to him and to his mourners.

Isaiah 61:1

[The Good News of Salvation] "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He (God, the Father) has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

EARLY CHURCH MINISTERING HEALING

Acts 5:16

Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all **heal**ed.

Acts 8:7

For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were **heal**ed.

Acts 9:34 (Speak The WORD of Healing to People)

And Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus the Christ **heal**s you. Arise and make your bed." Then he arose immediately.

Acts 10:38

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and **heal**ing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Acts 28:8-9

And it happened that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and dysentery. Paul went into him and prayed, and he laid his hands on him and **heal**ed him.

So when this was done, the rest of those on the island who had diseases also came and were **heal**ed.

HEALING AND THANKFULNESS

Luke 17:15

And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God,

INTERCESSION FOR HEALING

Acts 4:30

(Early Church prays) "by stretching out Your hand to **heal**, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."

James 5:16

Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be **heal**ed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

VERSES ON INFERTILITY

Genesis 20:17

So Abraham prayed to God; and God **heal**ed Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants. Then they bore children.

2 Kings 2:21-22

Then he went out to the source of the water, and cast in the salt there, and said, "Thus says the LORD: 'I have **heal**ed this water; from it there shall be no more death or barrenness.'" So, the water remains **heal**ed to this day, according to the word of Elisha which he spoke.

WEAKNESSES AND BONES

Psalm 6:2

Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am weak; O LORD, **heal** me, for my bones are troubled.

Proverbs 3:8

It (fear the Lord) will be **heal**th to your flesh, and strength to your bones.

Proverbs 15:30

The light of the eyes rejoices the heart, and a good report makes the bones **heal**thy.

Proverbs 16:24

Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the bones.
