## Request for bid for the sale of a Used Fire Engine





**Background:** Campton-Thornton Fire Rescue (“CTFR”) is in the process of re-designing its fleet. We are downsizing the number of engines in the fleet and therefore are putting this in-service Fire Engine up for sealed bid, as-is, where is, as seen, no warranties or guarantees expressed or implied. All lettering to be removed by CTFR prior to delivery.

**Submission of Bids:** Interested individuals are to submit a bid in a sealed envelope clearly marked “USED FIRE TRUCK BID” in bold or highlighted text. Bids are to be submitted and are to be delivered to CTFR no later than 4:00 p.m., on October 11, 2017. Bids are to be mailed or delivered to: Campton-Thornton Fire Rescue 186 NH Route 49, PO Box 1258 Campton, NH 03223. All bids that have been received will be opened in the Campton Town Hall Community Room in an open meeting, at the date and time of the deadline established above. Any bids received after the deadline will be returned unopened to the submitting individual. Faxed or e-mailed bids will not be accepted. The highest conforming bid will be selected.

**Minimum Bid:** \$2000.00. Bids below the minimum bid or otherwise non-conforming bids will be rejected.

**Pre-Bid Inspection:** All interested parties are invited to inspect the truck prior to bidding, by contacting CTFR Station #1 at 603-726-3300, during normal business hours M-F 8am to 4pm, and making arrangements to view the truck during the hours of normal operation.

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**PURCHASE AGREEMENT:** The selected bidder will, upon payment in full, be provided with a bill of sale transferring title to the vehicle with no warranties or guarantees (in a form as attached to the Request for bid).

**PAYMENT AND DELIVERY:** The selected contractor is to take possession of the used fire truck at Campton-Thornton Fire Station #1, 186 NH Route 49, Campton, NH, on a date mutually agreed by both the winning bidder and the department, within 7 days of award of bid, and remove it from the premises on that date. It is understood that the winning bidder will make a suitable inspection of the used fire truck prior to taking possession. CTFR firefighters will provide an operations demonstration and orientation to the winning bidder or a representative as needed. The winning bidder is to make payment in full by a cashier's check or in other form approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners, at the time of release. The department will provide any documentation pertaining to the vehicle at the same time payment is made. The department will also provide operations and maintenance manuals and repair and maintenance records that are in possession of the department at this time.
