Hello Friends,

In June, the CCEA received 878lbs of donated produce and other refrigerated food from our partnership with Dollar General and the Maryland Food Bank. This donation provided a real bonus for our Food Pantry. Despite this donation, we continue to distribute more food than we receive each month. In addition, payments for rent and utility assistance far exceed donations each month. The need in our community has not decreased.

The CCEA was founded 34 years ago as the outreach arm of the Churches of Chesapeake City. We currently have eight churches on our administrative board. The CCEA Pantries and programs are yours. Our volunteers come from the Chesapeake City Churches and Community. So please, if you are led to help your neighbors who are struggling, please do not forget the CCEA when you make that trip to the grocery store or when you set down to pay your monthly bills. We are also looking for volunteers, especially the need to fill the office of Vice President.
