WE DID IT! The first ever Bike-A-Thon really was a CCEA team effort. We had beautiful weather on Saturday, Sept. 30, and all the participants and volunteers had a good time. We had a variety of ages and abilities of participants who did many laps around our course in the Bo Manor Middle School parking lot. As first-time coordinator of this event, I have to say that I am so appreciative of the committee's efforts from months ago to now that made this idea come to fruition, as well as the volunteers who attended on the day of to make sure everything went smoothly. A week later, the Bike-A-Thon team had a meeting to evaluate the event and logistics, and we agreed that we succeeded with our

missions of both raising community awareness for the CCEA as well as starting a fund to use towards acquiring a new building. We raised just over \$7,000 for the building fund! Less event expenses, our net income was about \$5,500. We look forward to hosting the event again next year with just a few minor improvements, but mostly it was great!
