



2022 CONTRA COSTA COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

MEET INFORMATION

REGION

The Contra Costa County Championship Swim Meet, the County's premier recreational championship swim meet for the last 60 years, is open to invited recreational swim teams in Contra Costa County.

DIVISIONS

There will be three divisions in the meet. Teams will be entered in a division based on the number of entries in the meet. Team competition will be within the respective divisions only.

ENTRIES

Each contestant may enter two individual events for which he or she qualifies. The Individual Medley is considered one individual event. Each contestant may also swim in both relays, in addition to the individual events entered. Each team may enter 2 relay teams per event. Individual relay swimmers need not have met a County qualifying time.

FEES

The fees for the 2022 Contra Costa County Championship Swim Meet are as follows:

Swimmer Entry ("Splash Fee"):	\$15.00 per swimmer
Individual Event Fee:	\$15.00 per individual event
Relay Fee for each Relay:	\$30.00 per relay

RULES

Current USA rules, including the "whistle start" and "no recall" rules, will govern strokes, turns, starts, finishes, etc., with compliance enforced by the referees, starters, and stroke and turn judges. For ages 9 and up, "Flyover" starts will be used during trials. Coaches will be reminded of this at the coaches' meeting both days.

SWIMSUITS

We will be following all USA Swimming suit guidelines, including the tech-suit restrictions for 12 & under swimmers. Please visit contracostacountymeet.com for more tech suit information.

AWARDS

Participation Pins

- Championship Pins for every swimmer who qualifies for an individual event

Individual Awards

- Medals for 1st through 10th place in the final heat
- Rosette ribbons for 11th through 20th place in the consolation heat

Relays

- Medals for 1st through 10th places

Record Holders

- Record holder awards for individuals and relay teams that set a new standing meet record

High Point Swimmer

- One boy and one girl in each age group will be selected for this award, based upon points earned in individual events. Ties will be awarded to both swimmers.

Outstanding Relay

- One boys' team and one girls' team will be selected for this award, based upon performance relative to meet records, expressed as a percentage.

Division Winners

- Team trophies for 1st through 3rd place, based upon points earned.

AWARDS DISTRIBUTION

All awards and may be picked up by a team representative on **Monday August 1st**. No awards will be handed out during the meet. Specific time and location for pickup will be given prior to the meet. High Point Swimmer awards, Outstanding Relay awards, and Division Team trophies will also be available at that time.

PRELIMINARY HEATS AND FINALS

Individual Events

Preliminary heats will be held for all individual events except for the IM, which will be timed finals. The top 10 swimmers in each individual event will then participate in the Championship Finals for 1st through 10th place. Swimmers who finish in 11th through 20th place will compete in the Consolation Finals held immediately before the Championship Finals of the event. All finalists, including relays and alternates, must check in at the Clerk of the Course for their finals' events.

Relays

- Medley Relay timed finals will be the first event of the finals session on Saturday, Free Relay timed finals will be the first event of the finals session on Sunday.
- Names of the 4 swimmers in each relay and up to 2 alternates must be submitted with your team entries. These do not have to be the actual swimmers on that relay; however, any possible relay swimmer must be on your team roster and meet all County eligibility requirements. Swimmers can only be entered in one relay per event, meaning the same swimmer may not swim on both an "A" and a "B" relay. Alternates can be listed on more than one relay.

SCRATCHES

Scratches in preliminary heats are allowed and do not need to be reported to the desk; no replacements are allowed. Scratching from an event does not disqualify a swimmer from other events in the meet. In the finals session, if a swimmer scratches/no-shows for the consolation final, the 1st alternate will swim in their place. In the championship final, if a swimmer scratches/no-shows, no alternate swimmers will be entered, the lane will be empty.

CLERK OF THE COURSE

Every swimmer must check in and be seated at the Clerk of the Course prior to swimming their event. We use a double check in procedure. All swimmers must check in at the entrance desk of the Clerk and all swimmers must be in their chairs as the heat is released to the blocks. If a swimmer is not seated in their chair immediately prior to being released to the blocks, they will be scratched from the event. This is the same procedure for trials, finals, and relays. Coaches or parents should make sure all swimmers arrive at the Clerk of the Course on time. Only swimmers, and coaches of 8 and under swimmers, will be allowed inside the Clerk of the Course.
