Valuable Horseshoe Definitions

RINGER.....A method of scoring, mostly utilized by your opponent.


SHOE.....the device used by pitchers to score ringers and points, always designed with a large opening that fits around the stake on your opponent's shoe, usually with no opening at all on your own.

CANCELLATION.....An option used by your opponent should your shoe accidentally encircle the stake now and then.

DOUBLE.....the term for two ringers in succession when thrown by your opponent; referred to as a "miracle" when you do it.

50 POINTS.....the total points scored by your opponent before you are allowed to shake hands with him and show what a good sport you are.

PITS.....What you feel like when you get to shake your opponent's hand and show what a good sport you are.


