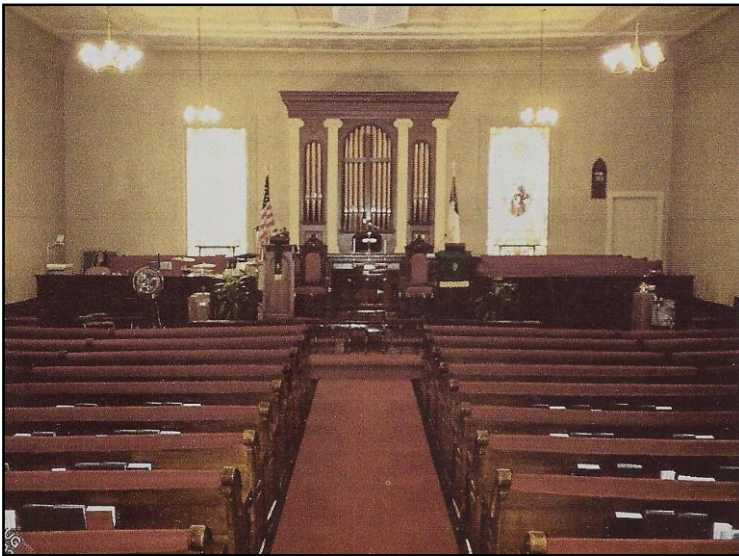

E. & G.G. Hook op 172 (1854) was built for the Unitarian Church in Exeter, NH. The organ and the church building changed congregations twice and was lastly owned by the United Methodist congregation. This instrument is a fine example of pre-civil war era organ building. The full specification of the Great is contrasted by a short compass Swell division typical of its time. We have restored E. & G.G. Hook op. 173 and 177 and know that the musical capabilities of this unique and historic instrument will ably support the music programs of a new setting.
