

This ca. 1870 William Stevens organ was last installed at Sacred Heart RC Church in Newfields, NH. The remaining parts of this organ are a testament to the fine craftmanship for which both George Stevens and his brother William are known. As with other instruments by Wm. Stevens, this organ has a gentle, yet colorful, sound that excels at supporting singing. The remaining parts of the organ include the windchest & pipework, the wind reservoir, the keyboard, and some key action and stop action. Constructing new casework and mechanical action will allow this organ greater flexibility to fit the architecture of any appropriately sized room. This organ would also be a great candidate for expansion, as a second manual could be added.

The drawing to the left is an example of a possible case that would suit this organ. We will be happy to supply a design that would be appropriate for this instrument and your sanctuary.
