**RESOLUTION IMPOSING RENT FOR USE OF OFFICE SPACE IN
MUNICIPAL BUILDING BY ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, Ross Township, Monroe County is a Township of the Second Class in Monroe County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Ross Township has previously provided office space in its Municipal Building located at 250 Anchorage Road, Ross Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, to the elected tax collector rent-free; and

WHEREAS, given increases in the expenses of building maintenance it is necessary to impose rent on the use of space in the Municipal Building by the elected tax collector; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has the authority by ordinance or resolution to adjust the compensation and/or emoluments of the elected tax collector in accordance with the Local Tax Collection Law, 72 P.S. 5511.1, *et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Ross Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that:

1. The elected Tax Collector of Ross Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, shall pay rent to Ross Township, Monroe County in the amount of One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$150.00) Dollars per month in exchange for the provision of office space in the Municipal Building for Ross Township located at 250 Anchorage Road, Saylorsburg, PA 18353.
2. The Board of Supervisors shall determine the extent and dimensions of office space to be provided to the elected Tax Collector and the hours the elected Tax Collector shall be permitted to use the office space.
3. The elected Tax Collector's obligation to pay rent will go into effect beginning with the next term of the elected tax collector to begin on January 1, 2030.
