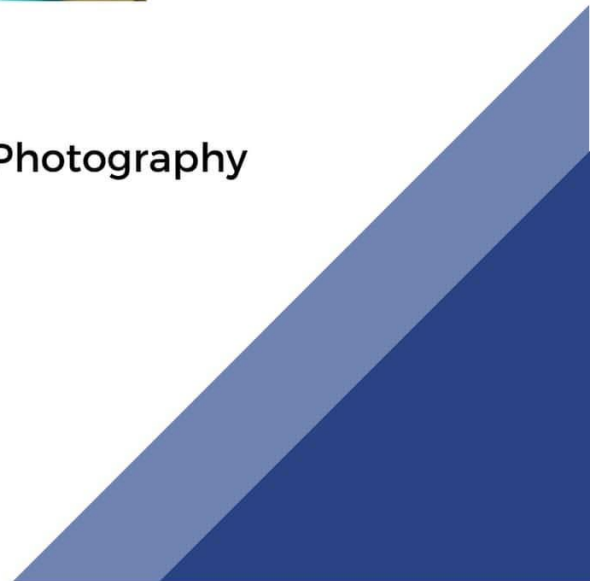

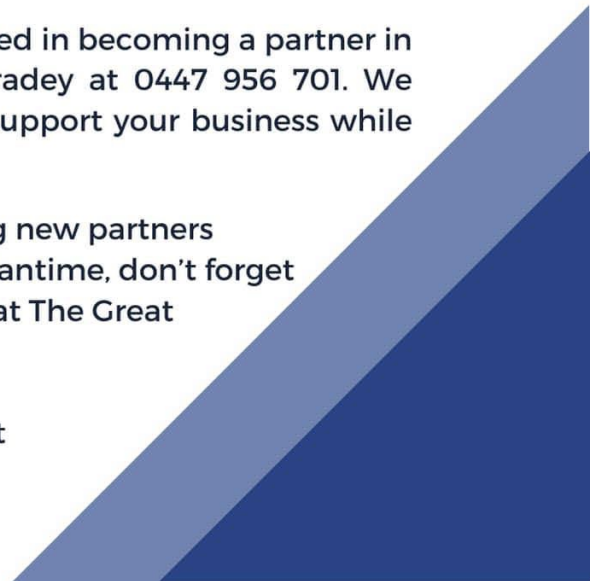

I put my hand up this year to Coach the clubs First Ever Under 11's All Girls Team and to say I am proud of these girls is an understatement.

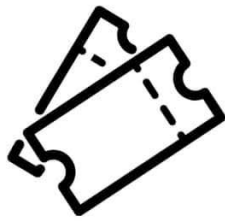

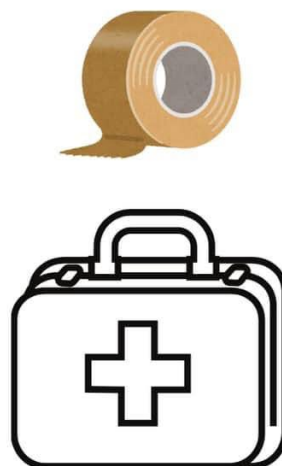

AROUND THE GROUNDS INFRASTRUCTURE

We wanted to take a moment to inform you about the latest developments regarding our club's infrastructure projects, which are set to enhance our facilities and support the future of Australian football in Rockhampton.

Field Improvements

Before the season got underway a dedicated team of volunteers got stuck into some hard yakka erecting the goal posts on our main field as well as our second field, adding topsoil and levelling out the fields. It was a massive job and marked a significant step towards enhancing accessibility as our sport continues to expand. Thank you to Luke Frenken and Dillon Butterfield for their work and equipment donation.

Being the first club in our region with two dedicated football fields is a tremendous accomplishment, made possible by the support of many.

Water Storage and Irrigation Upgrades

We are thrilled to announce that Brothers AFC has recently secured partial funding through the Queensland Government's Minor Infrastructure and Inclusive Facilities Projects.

This funding will be utilized to increase water storage (tank) for the existing irrigation system, ensuring sustainable water management that benefits all our fields.

We are actively working on securing additional support and funding to develop dedicated changeroom facilities for our women's and youth girls' teams. While toilets currently exist in the old softball building, additional funding will be required to retrofit the rooms, including painting , signage, new doors, cleaning and replacement of toilets.

Shade for visitors area

Currently, the visitors area of the main AFL field has no shade area. We want to ensure everyone can stay out of the sun as much as possible, so we're actively working on securing additional support to make that happen.

These initiatives underscore our dedication to inclusivity and ensuring equitable access to excellent facilities for all players, striving towards our vision to foster a strong and vibrant football community in Rockhampton.
