Welcome to Tony Clifford (TC) Memorial Day for 2026

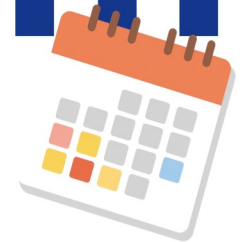
TC Day provides an opportunity for families and friends to come together in recognition of both past and present members of the Roos. It is a day dedicated to acknowledging everyone who has contributed to our club and remembering those who are no longer with us. It is a time to reflect on our shared experiences, lifelong friendships, and our collective passion for Australian Rules Football.

Throughout our history, we have fostered an inclusive culture where every member is valued and united by a commitment to playing, supporting and growing local footy.

This year has seen significant changes and improvements at Kele Park. New irrigation has been installed on the main field, along with an irrigation tank and pump station. Security lighting in the main carpark has provided peace-of-mind to after-hours visitors. The club secured funding last year for new changerooms as part of a two-year project that will deliver more inclusive facilities and improved access for everyone who plays, volunteers or visits Kele Park. In addition, we have a new portal scoreboard, and work will begin shortly to accommodate Brothers Cricket with new nets and a cricket pitch on the second field. Over the off-season, the main field will undertake work, including top dressing to improve the surface for the 2027 season.

Last year, the club played host to both the AFL Capricornia Youth Grand Final and the Senior Grand Final. It was the first time the AFL Capricornia Grand Finals have been hosted at Kele Park and a significant milestone in our club's history. The grand finals were even more special with the youth girls and senior women teams coming away with premierships.

We have continued to see improvement across all teams this year, and we are building a strong and sustainable club for the future. It is particularly pleasing that we have fielded teams every round throughout the season, with at least six of our seven teams qualifying for finals. Congratulations to everyone involved, and best of luck to all teams today and throughout the finals series.

I won't lie, at the start of this season, I was worried. Twenty players from our premiership-winning group didn't commit for 2026, for all sorts of reasons, and plenty of people quietly wrote us off. A full rebuild, they said. Impossible to back it up.

But we went to work, recruiting from the only place I truly know, TCC. On TC Day, we honour Tony Clifford, who founded this club so boys from Christian Brothers School, now TCC, would always have somewhere to belong once they left the classroom. Carrying that torch means everything to me, and bringing our TCC girls into this club, into this culture, has been one of the proudest parts of my year.

We were lifted further by players who crossed state lines to be part of something special. Hannah Smailes gave everything up forward before a cruel ACL injury ended her season early. Makayla Bellwood has been a rock all year, forward or back — never more so than grinding out an epic win over BITS with just 14 players on the field. 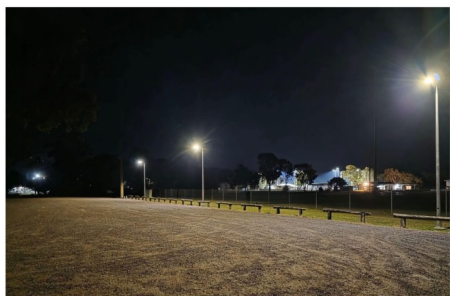

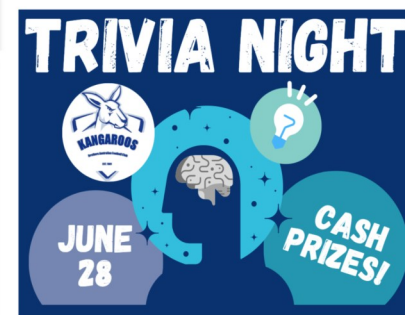
