A WORD FROM THE COACH WOMEN'S

From Wooden Spoon to Unbeaten: The Sisters' Remarkable Season

What a transformation! After last year's wooden spoon, our Sisters have delivered the season of a lifetime, heading into the final round with an unblemished record. If we secure victory on TC day, we'll make history as the first senior Brothers team to complete an undefeated season.

The turnaround has been extraordinary. We've achieved every goal set at season's start: fielding full 21-player teams for every match, winning on every ground in the league, and maintaining our defensive benchmark. Having scored just 129 points total last year, we challenged ourselves to concede fewer than that this season – sitting at just 97 points against with one game remaining.
