I continue to race in the Texas outlaw series (Lone Star Flat Track Assoc.) and in 2025 I earned class championships in the Pro Singles, Open Pro, and Pro-Am classes. My family and I have worked very hard to be as competitive as we can. We did not have any experience when I first started racing, but we get better each year, and we continue to learn and to focus on the fun and excitement of racing. I started my first job this year, and I work throughout the week, focus on my academic studies, and continue to train as much as I can (I ride daily, and I continue to improve on my strength and cardio training). GOALS: I would like to continue to improve on the 450cc in the upcoming season. I want to get better at understanding how to set the bike up and to make sure it operates at peak performance. I think I can ride in the 600cc class. I would like to be able to participate in enough races to place within the top 5 of that class in the CMRA Series. Finally, I would also like to attend 3-4 races in different States in 2026 (in addition to Amateur Nationals in Illinois).
