- For students who don't yet meet the 3100 requirement to become a candidate
- Recommended minimum:
 - 4 hours Professional Development meetings
 - 2 hours Community Service activities
- \$30 per semester

Candidacy and Membership

- Membership
 - Must commit to two semesters
 - Must complete first semester requirements to become a member
- 1st Semester \$100 Candidate
 - 6 hours of community service
 - 8 hours of professional development
- 2nd Semester \$50 Member
 - Same hour requirement as above

GPA Verification

- Both Candidates and Members must email a copy of their transcript to Professor Shumate
- NOTE: There is NO need to purchase an official transcript, unofficial is perfectly fine!
- Unofficial Transcript Instructions:
 - Go into Degree Works, Click ctrl-P (print), click the button that says Save as PDF, and make sure layout is Landscape, click Save.
