

































Candidates Requirements

- Must have declared a major IS, ISA, Finance or Accounting
- Must have completed the major-specific 3100 course
- Institutional and Major GPA 3.0 or above
- Attendance requirement per semester (you will get these hours throughout this semester by attending meetings):
 - 8 hours Professional Development meetings
 - 6 hours Community Service activities
- Submit registration form and pay Candidate fee of \$104 online at ksubap.com or submit a \$100 check payment
- Final registration and payment deadline: Thursday, February 1st, 2024 @ 11:59 pm

Member Requirments

Once initiated, members are expected to maintain a good standing until graduation by meeting the following:

- Institutional and Major GPA 3.0 or above
- Attendance requirement per semester:
 - 8 hours Professional Development meetings
 - 6 hours Community Service activities
- Submit registration form and pay Member fee of \$52 online at ksubap.com or submit a \$50 check payment
- Final registration and payment deadline: Thursday, February 1st, 2024 @ 11:59 pm
- If member does not maintain good standing, they will be placed on probation.

Financial Business Info Society

- You DO NOT meet all the requirements to be a candidate, but would like to have access and participate in the BAP-sponsored events
- Please note that FBIS members are not recognized by BAP national. FBIS is affiliated with BAP lota Tau Chapter only.
- Requirements:
 - No attendance requirement per semester, but recommend a minimum:
 - 4 hours Professional Development meetings
 - 2 hours Community Service activities
- Submit registration form and pay FBIS fee of \$32 online at ksubap.com or submit a \$30 check payment.
- Final registration and payment deadline: Thursday, February 1st, 2024 @ 11:59 pm

Non-BAP PD and CS Hours

- What if you can't attend enough BAP meetings to meet the hour requirement?
 - Members and Candidates may accumulate up to two hours of professional development and four hours of community service activities (Spring only) not sponsored by the BAP chapter.
 - Members and Candidates must complete the "Non-BAP CS and PD Hours Form" that can be found on ksubap.com/resources.

GPA Verification

 Both Candidates and Members must email a copy of your transcript to Professor Shumate at <u>sshumat2@kennesaw.edu</u> for GPA verification.

 To get your unofficial transcript, go into Degree Works in Owl Express and click CTRL-P, change the destination to Print to PDF, change the Layout to Landscape, and click Save.

BAP Chapter Contract

- Our Chapter requires a physical contract to be signed that discusses our requirements and expectations of being a part of the BAP lota Tau Chapter.
- Only Members and Candidates must sign and return the contract;
 FBIS should still review the BAP Code of Ethics.
- The signed contract is due by the meeting on Friday, February 2nd.
