

Ceremony Checklist: Start Strong, Stay Stress-Free

Your Guide to a Flawless Wedding Ceremony from Start to “I Do”



1. Sound & Mic Check (30–60 mins before)

- Ensure the officiant, readers, and musicians have tested their microphones
- Confirm backup batteries or power sources
- Place speakers to evenly cover the ceremony area

2. Guest Seating & Signage

- Assign someone to welcome and seat guests smoothly
- Place clear signage (e.g., “Unplugged Ceremony,” “Pick a Seat, Not a Side”)
- Reserve front-row seats for VIPs (parents, grandparents, etc.)

3. Cue Cards & Ceremony Agenda

- Provide a printed copy of the ceremony script to the officiant & DJ/MC
- Assign someone to cue the processional and music (usually DJ, planner, or coordinator)
- Ensure readers know where to stand, when to speak, and have their materials

4. Perfectly Timed Processional

- Create a [song cue list](#): prelude, wedding party, [bride's entrance](#)
- Time everyone's walk during rehearsal to the music
- Confirm song transitions with the DJ or live musicians

5. Staging & Photo Readiness

- Have the wedding party evenly spaced once standing
- Ask the officiant to step aside for the first kiss photo
- Remind everyone to pause and smile before exiting

6. Photo & Video Communication

- Share the timeline with photo/video teams in advance
- Create a no-guest-blocking photo policy if needed
- Confirm where cameras can be placed (especially for drone or aisle shots)

7. Contingency Plan for Weather or Delays

- Have umbrellas or fans for outdoor ceremonies
- Build in a 5–10 minute buffer into the timeline
- Prep an indoor backup plan if needed

8. Final Walkthrough with Key People

- Review roles with officiant, planner, DJ, photographer

- Reconfirm timing and order of entrance
- Encourage deep breaths, stay hydrated, and soak in the moment

Pro Tip: Appoint a calm, confident “Ceremony Captain” (planner, coordinator, or DJ) to run point. The couple should only have to show up and shine.
