This year's home tour includes a mixture of new and previous showings, including "crowd favorites."

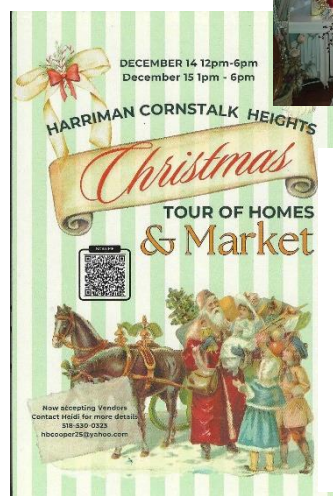

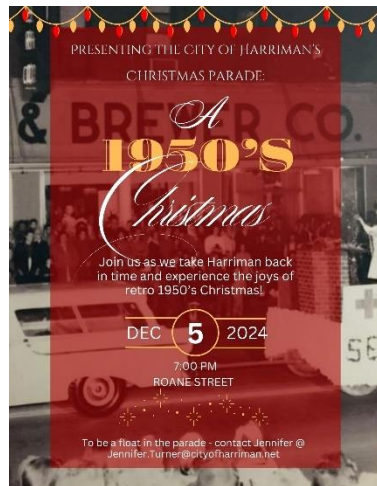

No Harriman Hall Workday in December

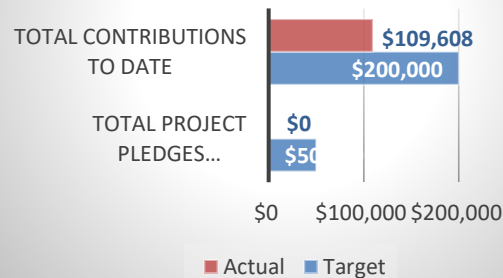
We are proud to show our year-to-year progress during our tours, and it will again be shown on the tour.
