While this has been the focus of my passion, there are several others of you



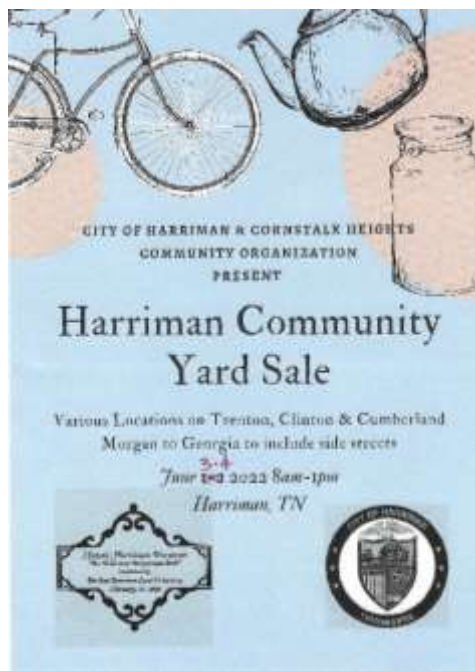

Harriman History Walk June 11th

The City of Harriman, in cooperation with CHHCO, is sponsoring History Walks on Saturday, June 11th, beginning at the Harriman History Museum adjacent to the Princess Theatre. The tours will run approximately 1-1.5 hours, with tours every half hour beginning at 10:00 am and last tour leaving at 1:00 pm. Three separate periods of time, from how the Civil War shaped Harriman's founding through what has influenced present day Harriman. The history will be told in 3 locations, requiring 3 short walks ending at the library. Tours are free, however donations will be gladly accepted towards preserving Harriman's History.

Success of April's Harriman Hall Workday

Several volunteers came out on the morning of April 23rd for the 1st Harriman Hall Workday of 2022! Teams were quickly organized to focus on the following tasks:

- Consolidation and sorting of wood and metal debris for site removal later
- Clearing of brush and leaves
- Weed-eating & trimming of vegetation
- Cleaning of front steps & porch landing
- Painting of top & inside of walls at steps
- Removal wood furring strips at windows
- Installation of additional protective plexiglass over completed exterior window restorations
- Development of punch list to determine priority & predecessor activities
