

SUNDAE CONCERT IN KILLEFFER PARK A SUCCESS

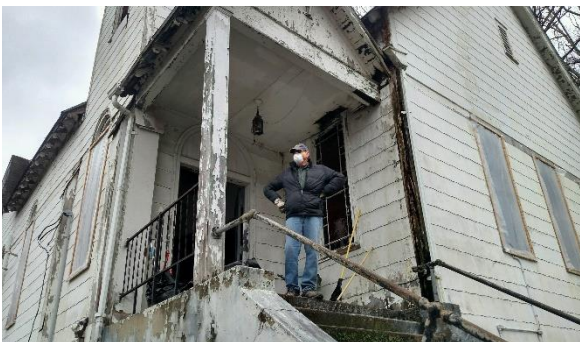


Despite the threat of rain, the Babahatchie Community Band performed

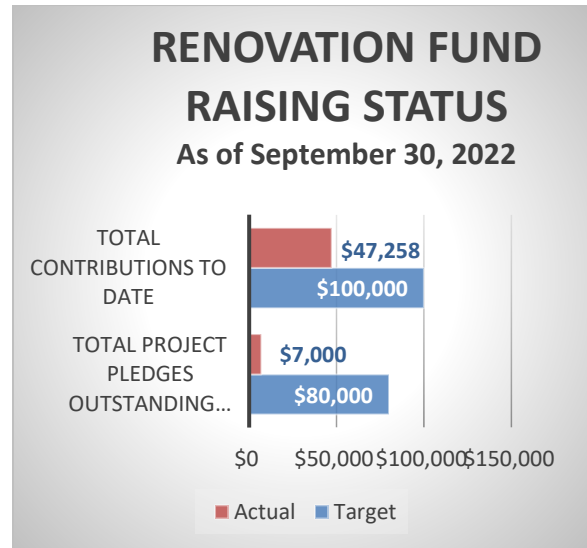




All donations go directly to the renovation of Harriman Hall, and are not used for any of the organization's operating expenses.
