

THE BIRD BUDDY

Assembly Instructions

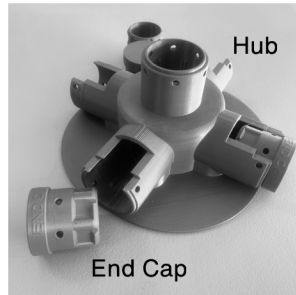
All Bird Buddy Perch parts are printed with their name for reference. Extra push pins are supplied; unused pins may remain after assembly.

*** DO NOT HAMMER ON OR PRY AGAINST ANY PART OF THE PERCH ***

PUSH PINS SHOULD NOT BE INSERTED UNTIL FINAL PERCH CONFIGURATION IS DETERMINED

1.

Place the **Hub** on a flat surface and rotate counter clockwise to remove any **End Caps**.



2.

Insert up to (4) **Landers** (textured surface) into open Hub side ports. Turn clockwise to lock and expose Push Pin holes.

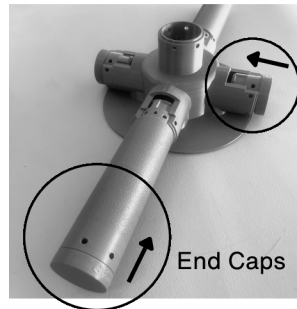
Use (4) pins to secure each Lander to the Hub side ports. (16) total if all Landers are used.



3.

Insert **End Caps** into the ends of the **Landers** and any open Hub ports. Turn clockwise to lock and expose Push Pin holes.

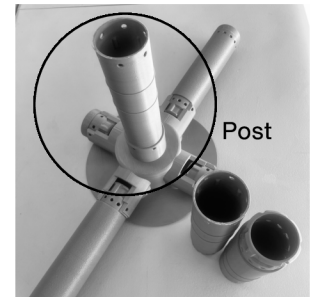
Use (2) pins for each End Cap, (8) total.



4.

Insert the first **Post** (smooth surface) into the Hub center port. Turn clockwise to lock and expose Push Pin holes.

Use (6) pins to secure the first post to the Hub center port.



5.

Insert additional **Posts** (smooth surface) to the required height. Turn clockwise to lock and expose Push Pin holes.

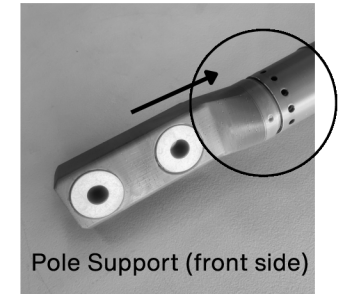
Use a minimum of (3) Push Pins for these connections.



6.

Insert the **Pole Support** into the End Post. The (back side) of the Pole Support should face the Pole sitting flush when attached. Turn clockwise to lock and expose Push Pin holes.

Use a minimum of (3) Push Pins.



7.

Press all **Push Pins** into exposed holes until flush with body. Reference each previous step for the number of push pins to use at each connection.



Final

Use (2) appropriate length bolts (not included) to fasten the perch to the pole or structure. **Do not overtighten Pole Support.**

Fasten the provided **Metal Strap** around the 'Strap Here' area on the Post nearest to the Pole Support.

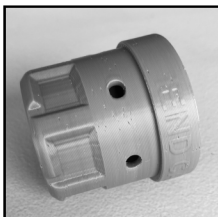

To avoid insect intrusion fill any open end with an End Cap

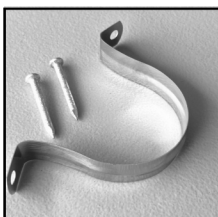
