Who: All African-American High School students enrolled in any Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County, or Westmoreland County Virginia High School with plans to pursue a higher education.

The Rules

- 1. All African-American High School students enrolled in any Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County or Westmoreland County Virginia High School with plans to pursue higher education.
- 2. The scholarship application deadline ends at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 15, 2021.
- 3. Entries should be limited to two pages plus the application form and cover sheet.
- 4. Each entry must be signed by the student with school counselors and civic representative(s) contact info.
- 5. The entry must be submitted on time. (No late entries will be accepted)
- 6. Include the title of your entry on both the first page of the essay and on the cover sheet.

How to Enter: In 500 words or less, write your response to the questions below:

Essay: This year's Black History Month Theme is the Black Family. According to the Association for The Study of African American Life and History (ASALH), "The black family has been a topic of study in many disciplines—history, literature, the visual arts and film studies, sociology, anthropology, and social policy. Its representation, identity, and diversity have been reverenced, stereotyped, and vilified from the days of slavery to our own time¹."

President Joe Biden has appointed you to a senior position within his cabinet. He has asked you for recommendations to help support his agenda for empowering the black families in this country. What are some of the greatest challenges facing the black families today? What do you tell him and why? What should be his top three priorities and why?

7. **Judging Criteria & Rules**: The winners will be selected by a neutral judging panel and will be rated in five areas:

a. Criteria

- (1) Currently enrolled as an African-American Senior in any **Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County or Westmoreland County Virginia High School**.
- (2) Good academic standing
- (3) Participation in the local community through civic programs and volunteerism
- (4) Plans to attend college after graduation from high school
- (5) Quality of essay
- b. **Rules**: The judging will take place under the supervision of **Dr. Sherry Springs**, Human Systems Engineer for the Department of the Navy. She will be joined by other community leaders to determine the winner of the scholarship.
 - (1) Participants agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the judges.
 - (2) All decisions are final.
 - (3) The winner will be notified by phone call by Monday, February 22, 2021.
- 8. Send a cover sheet with your entry and include the following information: Title of the entry, name, home address, applicant phone number, parent name, and cell phone number.
- 9. **Note**: Mail all entries to: The Virginia Black History Month Association James Farmer Scholarship, P.O. Box 41924, Fredericksburg, Virginia 22404. All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 15, 2021.
- 10. The Gala Details: Awards will be presented (online) during our Annual Black History Month (Virtual) Gala on Saturday, February 27, 2021. We would like for the winning contestant to be present (online) at the (Virtual) Gala. The winner will be given a free complimentary access to attend the Virtual Gala.
