## **Contest Rules**

- 1. This contest is open to <u>all 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students</u> currently enrolled in any Virginia Elementary School (or home schooled).
- 2. Contest ends Monday, May 2, 2022.
- 3. Writing entries should be limited to two pages plus cover sheet.
- 4. Each entry must be written by the student.
- 5. The entry must be neatly <u>handwritten</u> on standard ruled note paper.
- 6. Include the title of your entry on both the first page of the essay and on the cover sheet.
- 7. **HOW TO ENTER:** The essay should pertain to the following topic:

**Topic**: This year's Black History Month Theme is <u>Black Health and Wellness</u>. **Question**: Identify two African Americans (past or present) in the medical profession (i.e., doctor, nurse, technician, or specialist). Describe who they are and what makes them standout? Briefly discuss their work in the field of medicine. Compare the two professionals and tell us which one impressed you the most and why?

- 8. **Judging Criteria:** The three winners will be selected by a neutral judging panel and will be rated in three areas: writing skill, story content and originality.
- The list of panel members is Ms. Pamela Nephew (College Professor), Mr. Larry Marks (High School Principal) and Mr. Eugene Williams, (Author & High School Principal). Participants agree to be bound by these rules and the decision of the judges. All decisions are final. The top three winners will be notified by mail or phone call no later than Wednesday, June 1, 2022.

10. Send the enclosed cover sheet with each entry. Ensure you include the following:

- 11. The writing entry with the highest achievement will receive the first-place award; next highest achievement will receive the second-place award, and the third highest achievement will receive the third-place award.
- 12. Certificates will be presented during the Virginia Black History, Juneteenth, Father's Day Gala on Sunday, June 19, 2022 (Please arrive by 5:15pm). We would like for the winning contestants to be present at the Gala. In addition, the winners and one of their parent's will be given a free complimentary ticket to attend the Gala. The cost of adult tickets for additional attendees is adults: \$100.00, Students: \$60 and Children: (under 12 yrs. old) \$35.00 (Note: Children 5 yrs. old and under are free).
