

The 2022 Black History Month National Theme: "Black Health and Wellness"



What: The Virginia Black History Month Association James Farmer Scholarship.

When: The scholarship application <u>deadline</u> is **Monday, May** 16, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

Where: The Virginia Black History, Juneteenth, Father's Day Gala on Sunday, June 19, 2022 (6pm to 9pm) at the Crystal Gateway Marriott Hotel, 1700 Richmond Hwy, Arlington, VA 22202

Who: All African-American High School students enrolled in any Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County, or Westmoreland County Virginia High School with plans to pursue a higher education.

Why: To honor the legacy of renowned Civil Rights Leader Dr. James L. Farmer Jr.

The Monetary Awards
First Place Award: \$1,000

Second Place Award: \$500 Third Place Award: \$250

The Winners Will Receive:

- Monetary gifts from the Virginia Black History Month Association.

The Rules

- 1. All African-American High School students enrolled in any Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County or Westmoreland County Virginia High School with plans to pursue higher education.
- 2. The scholarship application deadline ends at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2022.
- 3. Entries should be limited to two typed pages plus the application form and cover sheet.
- 4. Each entry must be signed by the student with school counselors and civic representative(s) contact info.
- 5. The entry must be submitted on time. (No late entries will be accepted)
- 6. Include the title of your entry on both the first page of the essay and on the cover sheet.

How to Enter: In 500 words or less, write your response to the questions below:

Essay: This year's Black History Month Theme is "**Black Health and Wellness**." The theme focuses on the importance of Black Health and Wellness within the African-American communities.

Consider the following scenario: You have just been appointed as the Director for Community Outreach for a local hospital. The hospital is located within a predominately African-American community. With limited funding and limited staff your job is to make a positive impact on the overall health and well-being of your community. (1) Identify three medical conditions that disproportionately affect African-Americans within the local community you serve. (2) Describe how you would engage individuals in your community to become better stewards of their health. (3) As a liaison, how would you encourage members of the local community to utilize the resources available at your hospital?

7. **Judging Criteria & Rules**: The winners will be selected by a neutral judging panel and will be rated in five areas:

a. Criteria

- (1) Currently enrolled as an African-American Senior in any **Spotsylvania County, City of Fredericksburg, Caroline County or Westmoreland County Virginia High School**.
- (2) Good academic standing.
- (3) Participation in the local community through civic programs and volunteerism.
- (4) Plans to attend college after graduation from high school.
- (5) Quality of essay.
- b. **Rules**: The judging will take place under the supervision of **Dr. Sherry Springs**, Human Systems Engineer for the Department of the Navy. She will be joined by other community leaders to determine the winner of the scholarship.
 - (1) Participants agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the judges.
 - (2) All decisions are final.
 - (3) The winner will be notified by phone call no later than Wednesday, June 1, 2022.
- 8. Send a cover sheet with your entry and include the following information: Title of the entry, name, home address, applicant phone number, parent name, and cell phone number.
- 9. **Note**: Mail all entries to: The Virginia Black History Month Association James Farmer Scholarship, P.O. Box 41924, Fredericksburg, Virginia 22404. All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 16, 2022.
- 10. The Gala Details: Awards will be presented during the Virginia Black History, Juneteenth, Father's Day Gala on Sunday, June 19, 2022 (Please arrive by 5:15pm). We would like for the winning contestants to be present at the Gala. In addition, the winners and one of their parents will be given a free complimentary ticket to attend the Gala. The cost of adult tickets for additional attendees is adults: \$100.00, Students: \$60 and Children: (under 12 yrs. old) \$35.00 (Note: Children 5 yrs. old and under are free). (Note: All guests must be fully vaccinated to attend the gala and must wear mask when not eating or drinking)
