



## Hunting Checklist

### You should bring:

- Vehicle with some ground clearance; the county road is not paved.
- Valid Texas hunting license and Hunter's Ed Cert, if applicable.
- Gun(s) and ammo for each.
- Side arm/hand gun. (Recommended for protection against hogs, etc)
- Flashlights with extra batteries.
- Sharp knives and gloves for cleaning game.
- Insect repellent.
- Extra layers of clothing to adjust to temperature changes.
- Other hunting equipment, such as:
  - Compass and GPS
  - Binoculars
  - Range finder
  - Camera
  - Grunt call
  - Rattling bag
- Ice chests and plastic bags for butchered meat or the means to cover and transport your game to a processor; ice for the trip home.
- If taking more game than in the basic hunt, cash or credit card for fees.
- Food for your meals, including snacks and drinks.
- Personal toiletries (unscented soap, if wanted) and dirty clothes bag.
- Prescriptions and over the counter medicine for allergies, headaches, etc.

### We provide:

- Transportation to and from hunting areas
- A stand and shed to field dress game and a walk-in cooler to hang game
- Two bedrooms (3 twin beds each) with attached bathrooms. Includes bedding (pillow, sheets, blankets), towels, bathroom tissue, and soap
- Cooking utensils, pots and pans, refrigerator, plates/cups, and silverware
- Grill and smoker
- Coffee daily
- You may receive calls at 830-683-4325; outgoing calls are restricted except in an emergency. (Cell phones do not work in many areas of the ranch.)

**Note:** It is recommended that you sight-in your rifle before arriving at the ranch, but a target area is available, if needed.
