Remarkably, since its inception, The Queen's Court Inc. has raised over \$2,650,000 in support of charitable organizations dedicated to causes concerning health, homelessness, education, children and family welfare, Veterans, the arts, animal welfare, and many more.

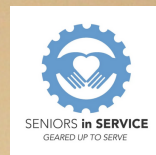

THE MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS Teen Poetry Fellowship



The Museum of Fine Arts (MFA) in St. Petersburg, FL has a Teen Poetry Fellowship that connects high school students with visual art through poetry workshops, culminating in a public spoken-word performance. The program includes a four-week paid fellowship for high school students (grades 9–12) that explores the link between visual art and poetry. Students receive guidance from local poets and museum educators; Students are encouraged to craft original poems inspired by the museum's collection and exhibits. The program concludes with a spoken-word performance and the creation of a published collection of the students' poems.

SENIORS IN SERVICE Classroom Grandparents Program



The "Seniors in Service Classroom Grandparent" program is a volunteer opportunity for individuals aged 55 and over to mentor and provide support in elementary school classrooms in Hillsborough and Pinellas counties. As part of the national AmeriCorps Seniors Foster Grandparent Program, volunteers help with literacy, classroom management, and social-emotional development for children, particularly those who are struggling or at-risk. The program offers training, support, and a small stipend for eligible low-income volunteers, along with benefits like a sense of purpose and improved well-being for the seniors involved.
