


Course Description. The out-and-back course starts and finishes at the north entrance of the Jennings Landing amphitheater on the Hudson River and is run entirely on the pavement of the Mohawk Hudson Bike Trail. The course proceeds north thru the Corning Preserve and the Boat Launch areas, continuing under the I-90 Patroon Island bridge to the turnaround at exactly 2.5 km.

Key Points Description Described as race is run

<u>Start/Finish:</u> At the seam between the asphalt pavement and the cobble transition at the north end of the Jennings Landing amphitheater (by stairway leading down to the river.

Mile 1: On bike trail after fenced narrow area. Point is 28'0" before wooden post "MI 10.5" on R. No other landmarks available.

<u>Turnaround</u>: On bike trail approx. 583' after northern abutment for I-90 Patroon Island bridge. Point is 282' 6" after wooden post "MI 11.0" on R. No other landmarks available.

Mile 2: On bike trail at curve by picnic tables. Point is even with first concrete slab for picnic table on R.

<u>Mile 3:</u> On bike trail in Corning Preserve. Point is 69' 5" after lamp post #15 on R and 57' 6" before intersecting path on R leading to bridge over tidal ponds.

All points marked with mag nail and orange paint.
