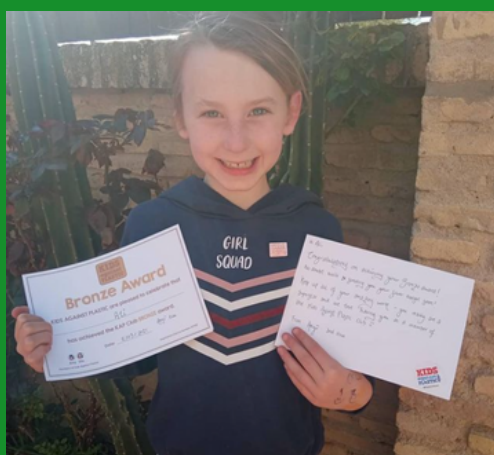

# Ali's Top Litter Picking Tips!




1. Grab your picker or a glove
