1. Every day approximately **3 million** pieces of plastic pollution find their way into our oceans.

(OSPAR, 2009)

Plastics make up 80% of all marine debris\* studied.
 (IUCN, 2020)

3. Plastic pollution kills over 100,000 marine mammals and over **1 MILLION** sea birds every year.

(UK Government, 2018)

4. Around 2,000 items of marine plastic pollution have been found per kilometre of beach in the UK.

(Marine Conservation Society, 2016)
