Dinners will be takeout only. A drive through pick up will take place in the rear parking lot near the handicapped sidewalk cut out. Dinners are \$12 and will include a beer battered fillet, coleslaw, french fries, and a roll. Additional orders of fries are available for \$1. If possible, pay with exact cash or a check made payable to Christ Church to speed the pick-up process. Credit card payment will NOT be accepted.

#### **New Technology for Christ Church Sanctuary**

Our experience during covid-19 has taught us how important and helpful it is to have filming, recording, and live-streaming capability in our sanctuary. Even after we begin to regather for in-person worship, we will need and want to continue to post our worship services online.






Christ Church tee shirts are available for sale at coffee hour and in the office. They come in sizes S, M, L, and XL for \$10 and 2XL for \$12.

Our clients do need to be ambulatory. F.I.S.H. is made up of all volunteers who give their time to dispatch, drive, or serve on various F.I.S.H. committees. We need scheduled drivers (one day a month) or random drivers (on an as-needed basis). If you prefer not to drive, we are in need of dispatchers, too. Dispatchers take the calls from clients one week a month and try and find drivers to transport them.
