**Workshop Description and Information:** Equine Assisted Psychotherapy (EAP) and Learning (EAL) is an innovative approach to professional counseling using horses to help client's address and resolve behavioral, relational, psychological, spiritual, and emotional issues. The workshop will focus on a program entitled "Equine Leading and Learning," based on Franklin Covey's student leadership program *The Leader in Me*. Participants will better understand the model of equine assisted learning through theory, role definition (mental health professional and equine specialist), activities, and processing techniques.

Although the program is designed to help troubled adolescents gain leadership skills and exhibit more positive behaviors, the concepts can be applied to many different venues and age groups as an intervention tool. Participants will be able to identify what clients are most likely to benefit as the presenters offer information about the versatile applications of Equine Assisted Psychotherapy and Learning.

This is an experiential workshop. Didactic presentations will be intermittently supported by work in the arena with horses.
