Rules, Terms, and Conditions for Plot Reservation and Participation

Once a plot is assigned, I will abide by the following rules, terms, and conditions:

- **1.**I use this garden at the sole discretion of the Weston Community Garden. I agree to abide by its policies and practices.
- **2.** The fee for the use of the garden is \$150 per plot, per year. This fee also includes membership. There are no refunds.
- **3.** Once I have been assigned a plot, I will cultivate and plant in it within 30 days. I may garden year-round. My plot cannot be left fallow or unused for any period of three weeks or longer. If it is left unused during my reservation period, I will still keep it maintained and tidy.
- **4.** My plot is (4 x 10) feet. I will not expand my plot beyond this measurement or into paths or other plots. I will keep all my plants within the limits of my garden plot, and I will do my best to keep my plot free of weeds, pests, and diseases.

- **5.** I will keep my plot, paths, and surrounding areas clean and neat. I will separate my trash into three groups: 1) dead plants, leaves, and other green waste plant parts; 2) rocks or limestone 3) paper, plastic, cardboard, wood, metal, etc. I will put each type of trash only in the areas designated specifically for each. Anything I bring from my home I will take back home. I will not bring household trash and leave it at the Ann Wasserman Memorial Community Garden.
- **6.** I will not apply any pesticides or herbicides in the garden.
- **7.** I will not plant any illegal plants. I will not smoke or use illegal drugs in the garden. I will not bring weapons or pets or other animals into the garden.
- **8.** Guests and visitors, including children, may enter the garden only if a member accompanies them. They must follow all rules, terms, and conditions stated here. Children must be always supervised when they are in the garden. I am solely responsible for the behavior of my guests.
- **9**. I will not share the combination lock with anyone.

- **10.** I will respect other gardeners, and I will not use abusive or profane language or discriminate against others. No physical violence of any kind will be tolerated and may result in expulsion from the garden.
- **11.** I will not take food or plants from other gardeners' plots. I will not take anything from the garden that is not rightfully mine.
- **12.** Tools borrowed will be returned in reasonably clean condition and stored properly. If any damages are noted to any of the equipment, the gardener will inform a board member so that the tool can be repaired or replaced; we don't want anyone using broken tools as that would be a hazard.
