- Vetting Volunteer Applications.

INFORMATION PROTECTION:

We implement reasonable physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard personal information. Access to personal information is restricted to authorized personnel only.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION:

We will not sell, rent, or trade personal information to third parties. We may only disclose personal information when required by law or with the consent of the individual.

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS:

INDIVIDUALS HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- · Access their personal information held by us.
- Request corrections to any inaccuracies in their personal information.
- Withdraw consent for the use of their personal information at any time.

AMENDING THE POLICY FOR PROTECTING PRIVACY:

This policy can only be amended by a decision of the Senior Pastor and Servant Team in cooperation with the Oversight Board following the Bylaws.
