

Overview:

Students at Kingdom Life Academy can take college courses online or in person while in high school. These college courses can be applied to high school graduation requirements. We strongly recommend parents wait until their child's 10th-grade year to consider dual enrollment, as these classes are challenging and have permanent markings on their school records.

Application Process: For the community college application process, students need to apply online to the college of their choice. For Saddleback College, click here and follow the steps for the new student application.

This is a recommended timeline for students to follow each semester.

Step One: Completed by June (for Fall) and October (for Spring)

• Complete the California Community College Online Form (CCC)

Step Two:

 Meet with Kingdom Life Administration for academic advisement and choose your classes. **Note: Students may not exceed 11 college units per <u>California State</u> regulations.

Step Three: Completed by July (for Fall) and December (for Spring)

- Complete a K-12 Special Admissions Form
 - The school's name is the one you used when filling out your PSA with the state.
 - If you are using a charter school, you will need to submit the K-12 Special Admissions form to your school for approval
- Submit the signed form to Community College Admissions Department
 - o The school will email your child with confirmation of approval

Step Four: Completed in August (for Fall) and January (for Spring) *Refer to college calendar registration for high school students
